- The Florida Department of Law Enforcement (F.D.L.E.) has certified the Log Cabin and Ed Burke Park Recreational Centers as certified non-high liability training locations. This will allow the Village of Biscayne Park Police Department to host F.D.L.E. Certified Course. From July 8 to 12, 2024, the Village of Biscayne Park Police Department has agreed to assist the Tallahassee Community College, Florida Public Safety Institute host a speed measurement device operators' course (radar training) for numerous law enforcement officers from across the state. This also provides the police department with free training opportunities, and will at the completion of training, all paid police officers will be certified as speed measurement device operators.

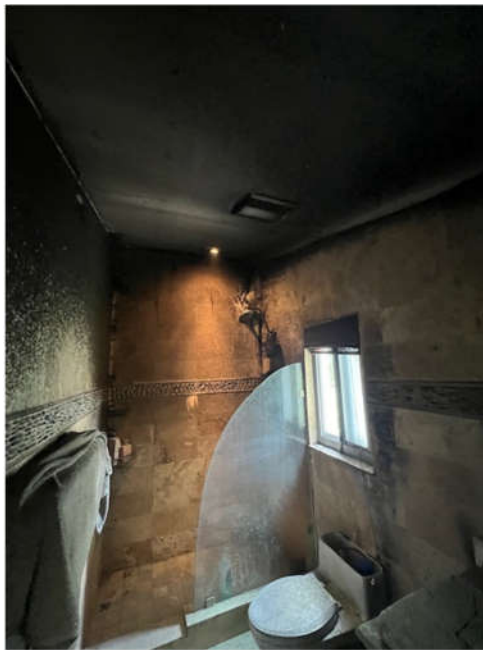




## Village of Biscayne Park Police Department June 2024 Monthly Statistical Summary Acting Chief Mark T. Steele, D.M.



- On Monday, June 10, 2024, police units were dispatched to Northeast 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Northeast 116<sup>th</sup> Street in reference to a residential house fire. Detective Louie Rodriguez, Officer Jorge Rosero, Officer Dania Rodriguez, and Officer Santiago Cornes swiftly responded to a structural fire incident. Their quick actions resulted in the safe evacuation of three individuals and a canine companion from the affected residence. Furthermore, these officers displayed exceptional bravery by entering the premises that were pitch black with smoke to ensure that all individuals were out and ultimately suppressed the fire, safeguarding both lives and property.



- From June 12<sup>TH</sup> to 15<sup>TH</sup> the Biscayne Park Police Department with assistance from the Biscayne Park Public Works Department personnel responded to the Village in reference to a state of emergency. Police Department personnel responded immediately to assist with evacuations, shoring flooded houses, assisting with sandbag distribution and securing houses, traffic control and road closures, and welfare checks of residents. Personnel also assisted with coordination with the Miami-Dade County Emergency Operations Center to obtain two large pumps, and the set-up and breakdown of the pumps to assist the residents.
