NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Village of Biscayne Park is seeking sealed proposals from qualified Proposers for the following work:

Proposals must be sealed and clearly marked: **"RFP No. 2026-001 – Village NE 6th Avenue Median Landscape Maintenance Services."** Late submissions will not be considered. Proposals will be opened publicly and read aloud immediately following the submission deadline.

Pursuant to §287.057(25), Florida Statutes, Proposers (respondents) or persons acting on their behalf may not contact, between the release of this solicitation and the end of the 72-hour period following the Village's posting of the notice of intended award, any employee, officer, or elected official of the Village concerning any aspect of this solicitation, except in writing to the Procurement Contact designated herein. Violation of this provision may be grounds for rejecting a proposal.

Pursuant to §119.071, Florida Statutes, sealed bids, proposals, or replies are exempt from public inspection until the Village issues a notice of intended decision or within thirty (30) days after opening, whichever is earlier. The Village reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, with or without cause, to waive technicalities and informalities, and to accept the proposal that best serves the interests of the Village.
