

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-59

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-139 OF THE VILLAGE'S CODE OF ORDINANCES AND APPROVING A FIVE YEAR AGREEMENT WITH AXON ENTERPRISE, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIFTEEN (15) TASERS AND THE NECESSARY HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, LICENSES AND WARRANTIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FIFTY-THREE CENTS (\$66,664.53) OVER THE FIVE YEAR TERM; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT AND DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Biscayne Park ("Village") Police Department is in need of replacing and upgrading the Taser devices carried by its police officers which have reached their useful life and to facilitate the provision of the Police Department's day to day operations; and

WHEREAS, Axon Enterprise, Inc. ("Axon") is the sole provider of the equipment, hardware, software, licenses and warranties for the Taser device and has provided a quote for a five (5) year Agreement in the amount of Sixty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars and Fifty-Three Cents (\$66,664.53), attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", for the purchase of fifteen (15) tasers and the required associated hardware, software, licenses and warranties and a Master Services and Purchase Agreement which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-136(c) of the Village Code requires that any purchase of goods or services in excess of \$10,000 shall be approved by the Village Commission after the goods or services are competitively bid as required by Village Code Section 2-137; and

WHEREAS, Village Code Section 2-139 authorizes the waiver of the competitive bidding procedures by a majority vote of the Village Commission upon the recommendation of the Village Manager that said waiver is in the best interest of the Village to do so due to insufficient time, the nature of the goods or services or other factors; and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager recommends, based on the nature of the goods and that Axon is the sole provider of the Taser device and the associated hardware, software, licenses and warranties,

that it is in the best interest of the Village to waive the competitive bidding procedures and enter into an agreement with Axon for the purchase of fifteen (15) Taser devices and the required associated hardware, software, licenses and warranties of which said Tasers are necessary to facilitate the day to day operations of the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.


Section 2. Waiver of Competitive Bidding Procedures. The Village Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park, pursuant to Section 2-139 of the Village’s Code of Ordinances, hereby waives the competitive bidding procedures outline in the Village’s Code of Ordinances Article VIII “Purchasing and Procurement” upon the recommendation of the Village Manager that it is in the best interest of the Village to do so.

Section 3. Approval of Agreement. The Village Commission hereby approves a five (5) year Agreement with Axon Enterprise, Inc. for the purchase of fifteen (15) Taser devices and the required associated hardware, software, licenses and warranties in a total amount not to exceed Sixty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars and Fifty-Three Cents (\$66,664.53), which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”.

Section 4. Authorization of the Village Manager. The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute said Agreement, subject to review by the Village Attorney, and do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.


Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.


