6a Ordinance 2022-08- Millage Rate FY 2022-2023(Second Reading)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE 2022-2023 MILLAGE RATE AT 9.50 MILS FOR EACH \$1,000 OF ASSESSED VALUATION UPON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Village Attorney Valerie Vicente read the Ordinance into the record

Village Attorney Valerie Vicente read into the record that the millage rate will be at 9.50 Mils per each 1,000 of assessed value, which is 14.58% greater than the roll back rate of 8.9214.


Commissioner Kennedy thanked the Village Manager and staff for a successful budget season. The Village Manager thanked the Mayor, Vice Mayor and Commission.
